



Press Release - May 25, 2017

A contractor has severed a water main located along 5th Ave. this morning near Memorial Park. Crews have repaired the main. As result of the event we have determined that a boil water advisory is necessary for the residents in the Grand Oaks area south of US 62, the area between East 7th Ave., Hickory St. and Oak Blvd as well as an area along Fifth Ave. from Hickory St. to Maple Ave. Customers along the following streets in the Great Oaks Subdivision will be affected by the order.

- Grand Oaks Rd.
- 18th Avenue
- Helton St
- Grant St.
- Lone Valley Rd. from the intersection of Grand Oaks Rd. to the intersection with Little Rock Lane

The other streets in the Boil Water Advisory include:

- East 7th Ave. from Hickory St. to Oak Park Blvd.
- Hickory St. from 7th St. south
- Laurel Dr.
- Juniper St.
- Linden St.
- Country Club Ln.
- Fifth Avenue from Hickory St. to Maple Avenue

Customers should flush household pipes/faucets, home automatic ice makers, water fountains, etc. Water should be brought to a rolling boil for a minimum of 3 minutes prior to consumption. Customers with infants, elderly or immune-compromised individuals should seek advice about drinking water from their health care providers.
